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Hi people at The Write Score,

I've come across some anomalies with the solo string instruments in S7S and The Write Score Soundsets. It may be my lack of understanding how the S7S sounds and soundsets work - but it may also be that something isn't quite set up correctly in the soundsets. I was wondering if you could enlighten me.

I was exploring entering text into Solo Violin 1 while I was trying out the S7S Library_7.1.2 template with the S7S Library Soundset (as downloaded from the Sibelius website), and I found that entering pizz and bartok pizz produced bartok pizz only. Since this seemed odd, I thought I would try other markings that I would expect to get with a solo violin, and I realized that I was getting another sound that isn't mentioned in your Maps (col legno). I found similar problems in some of the other solo strings files. Not being clear whether this was an issue with the Soundsets or the library or me, I have systematically tried this in every combination of Soundset and MS or template that I could think of, and I've entered the results in the attached table.

I would be grateful if you could explain to me what is happening here. Many thanks.

- i. Please also note the issue with Cello Solo 2 appearing as Cello Solo 1.
- ii. The unexpected bartok pizz sounds mentioned above, whenever they are in Solo Violin and Solo Cello, they sound like an ensemble bartok pizz, not a solo one. All cello and bass bartok pizzes sound like regular solo instruments.
- iii. I'm also attaching the three .sib files I used, so you can see how I went about testing the instruments.
